Energy: Expediting LNG Exports

- Led a Permian Basin tour for House E&C Chairman Guthrie and five other committee members
- Two Pfluger energy bills passed the House
 - The Unlocking Our Domestic LNG Potential Act
 - The Protecting American Energy Production Act
- Hosted Maria Bartiromo from Fox Business for an exclusive energy industry tour and interview

Environment: Rolling Back Biden EPA Regulations

- Brought the EPA Region 6 Administrator to Midland
- Pfluger's CRA to reverse Biden's Natural Gas Tax was the 2nd bill signed into law by President Trump this year
- Pfluger's permitting reform legislation, the Foreign Emissions and Nonattainment Clarification for Economic Stability (FENCES) Act, was passed out of the Environment Subcommittee
- Led legislation to delay the natural gas tax by 10 years in H.R. 1

Communications & Telecommunications: Closing the Digital Divide

- Leading oversight of \$3+ billion in Texas BEAD funding
- Previewed legislation in a C&T Subcommittee hearing called the Mystic Alerts Act to modernize public safety communications
- The C&T Subcommittee also passed Pfluger's Federal Broadband Deployment Act

Health Care: Improving Access and Lowering Costs

- Introduced the More Affordable Care Act to lower health care costs, expand patient choice, and increase price transparency
- Led the effort for Texas's application to be prioritized in the \$50 billion Rural Health Transformation Program disbursements
- Introduced the Biosimilar Red Tape Elimination Act to lower prescription drug prices and ensure everyone has affordable access to medication
- Voted to pass legislation to lower health care premiums by 11%

HOUSE HOMELAND SECURITY COUNTERTERRORISM AND INTELLIGENCE SUBCOMMITTEE CHAIRMAN

Supporting law enforcement, bolstering border security, and protecting the Homeland

Led five CTI Subcommittee hearings to address critical issues such as the rise of antisemitism in America, online radicalization, and today's terror landscape

Two Pfluger bills were passed through the full Homeland Committee and the U.S. House:

- The DHS Restrictions on Confucius Institutes and Chinese Entities of Concern Act
- The Generative AI Terrorism Risk Assessment Act

One Pfluger bill was passed through the CTI Subcommittee:

- The Countering Transnational Repression Act

Critical homeland security specific wins secured in the Working Families Tax Cut law:

- \$13.5 Billion in Border Reimbursements for Texas, funding to complete the border wall, increase CBP facilities and vehicles, additional CBP workforce and boost retention, enhance drug detection and border surveillance technology, and investments in unmanned aircraft systems and Operation Stonegarden

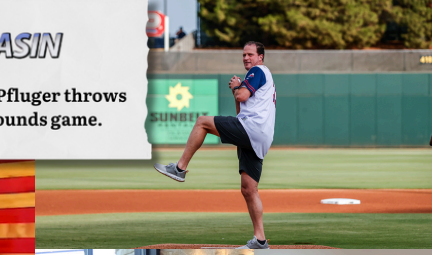
