Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Aggie Conservation Corps project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Texas A&M AgriLife Research, located at 7887 U.S. Highway 87 North, San Angelo, Texas 76901. The funding would be used to deploy student-led field teams to work directly with landowners to conduct land-health monitoring, develop conservation and restoration plans, and provide practical reporting tools aligned with USDA Natural Resources Conservation Service priorities. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it supports proactive land stewardship, reduces long-term federal disaster and recovery costs related to drought and wildfire, strengthens agricultural productivity, and builds a skilled conservation workforce in rural communities while leveraging existing land-grant university infrastructure.

The project has a federal nexus because it is for the purposes authorized by the Soil Conservation and Domestic Allotment Act of 1935, 16 U.S.C. §§ 590a-590d and 590f-g.
