## **Federal Disaster Declaration Fact Sheet**

July 16, 2025

On July 6, 2025, President Donald J. Trump granted a Major Disaster Declaration for the State of Texas triggering the release of federal funds to help people and communities recover from Severe Storms, Straight-line Winds, and Flooding that began July 2, 2025, and continuing. **This disaster declaration has been amended as indicated below in bold.** Details of the disaster declaration and assistance programs are as follows:
