## **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Early Action and Re5 sponsiveness Lifts Youth Minds Act" or the "EARLY
6 Minds Act".

## 1 SEC. 2. EARLY INTERVENTION.

2 STATE PLAN **OPTION.**—Section (a) 3 1912(b)(1)(A)(vii) of the Public Health Service Act (42) 4 U.S.C. 300x-1(b)(1)(A)(vii) is amended— 5 (1) in subclause (III), by striking "and" at the 6 end; 7 (2) in subclause (IV), by striking the period at 8 the end and inserting "; and"; and 9 (3) by adding at the end the following: 10 "(V) a description of any evidence-based 11 prevention and early intervention strategies and 12 programs the State provides to prevent, delay, 13 or reduce the severity and onset of mental ill-14 ness and behavioral problems, including for children and adolescents, irrespective of experi-15 16 encing a serious mental illness or serious emo-17 tional disturbance, as defined under subsection 18 (c)(1).".

19 (b) ALLOCATION ALLOWANCE; REPORTS.—Section
20 1920 of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 300x–
21 9) is amended by adding at the end the following:

"(e) PREVENTION AND EARLY INTERVENTION SERVICES.—In the case of a State with a State plan that provides for strategies and programs specified in section
1912(b)(1)(A)(vii)(V), such State may expend not more
than 5 percent of the amount of the allotment of the State

1	pursuant to a funding agreement under section 1911 for
2	each fiscal year to support such strategies and programs.
3	"(f) Reports to Congress.—Not later than Sep-
4	tember 30, 2025, and biennially thereafter, the Secretary
5	shall provide a report to the Congress on the prevention
6	and early intervention strategies and programs pursued by
7	States pursuant to subsections (e). Each such report shall
8	include—
9	"(1) a list of the States that utilized the option
10	to provide prevention and early intervention services;
11	"(2) a description of the each State's preven-
12	tion and early intervention activities;
13	"(3) the population served, including informa-
14	tion on demographics, including age;
15	"(4) the outcomes of such activities, includ-
16	ing—
17	"(A) how such activities reduced delays in
18	access to mental and behavioral health care for
19	children and adults; and
20	"(B) how such activities reduced the sever-
21	ity of onset of serious mental illness and serious
22	emotional disturbance; and
23	"(5) any other relevant information the Sec-
24	retary deems necessary.".
