I am requesting funding for the *Renovate to Innovate: Creating a Modern Advanced Skills Workforce Training Center for the Future* project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Howard College, located at 3501 U.S. Highway 67, San Angelo, Texas 76905.
