I am requesting funding for the *I-27 / I-14 Future Interstate System Connection Study* in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Ports-to-Plains Alliance, located at the project address in San Angelo, Texas 76901. The funding would be used for planning, feasibility analysis, and engineering studies to evaluate and design the optimal Interstate-standard connection between Future Interstate 27 and Interstate 14 in West Texas. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it supports long-term infrastructure planning that will improve freight mobility, enhance military readiness, reduce congestion, and strengthen economic development across the region while ensuring future construction investments are data-driven and cost-effective.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized under **23 U.S.C. § 133(b)(10)**, which permits the use of federal surface transportation funds for transportation planning and development activities, including feasibility studies and corridor planning on the National Highway System.
