Dear Chairman Simpson and Ranking Member Pingree:

I am requesting funding for the Wastewater Plant Packaged Pump Station Replacement project for Eden, Texas in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Eden, located at 120 Paint Rock Street, PO BOX 915, Eden, Texas 76837.

The funding would be used to replace the existing transfer pump station at the City of Eden Wastewater Plant, including new pumps, control panels, and structural housing. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the current station—over eight years old—suffers from equipment failure (including an electrical panel fire) and requires manual operation that diverts staff from other critical water and wastewater tasks. A modern packaged pump station will restore operational efficiency, ensure reliable transfer of reuse water to Concho Springs Golf Course and Hardin Creek, support compliance with TCEQ effluent limitations, and provide a sustainable water source during drought conditions, wildfires, and agricultural needs.

This project has a Federal nexus because Title VI of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C. 1381 et seq.
