1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Terrorist Inadmis-  
3 sibility Codification Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. INCLUSION OF HAMAS, HEZBOLLAH, AL-QAEDA,**  
5 **PALESTINE ISLAMIC JIHAD, AND ISIS OFFI-**  
6 **CIALS AND MEMBERS AMONG ALIENS EN-**  
7 **GAGED IN TERRORIST ACTIVITY.**

8 Section 212(a)(3)(B)(i) of the Immigration and Na-  
9 tionality Act (8 U.S.C. 1182(a)(3)(B)) is amended, in the  
10 undesignated matter following subparagraph (IX), by  
11 striking “or spokesman of the Palestine Liberation Orga-  
12 nization” and inserting “spokesperson, or member of the  
13 Palestine Liberation Organization, Hamas, Hezbollah, Al-  
14 Qaeda, ISIS, Palestine Islamic Jihad, or any successor or  
15 affiliate group, or who endorses or espouses terrorist ac-  
16 tivities conducted by any of the aforementioned groups,”.
