
I am requesting funding for the SAPD/PSC Technology Upgrade Program in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the San Angelo Police Department, located at 401 E. Beaugard, San Angelo, TX 76903.

The funding would be used to update server capacity and storage for the 911 Dispatch Computer Aided Dispatch system; upgrade desktop computers to meet Windows 11 TPM 2.0 requirements; and purchase 20 ticket writers with Hexagon interface capabilities. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it replaces out-of-warranty critical infrastructure purchased in 2017, ensures compliance with FBI CJIS security policy, dramatically reduces manual data entry (saving over a minute per traffic stop across 29,404 annual stops), improves officer safety through license/vehicle data scanning, and enhances the efficiency and reliability of public safety communications and records management.

This project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes described in section 20102 of title 51, United States Code. Additionally, the equipment upgrade is required to meet requirements under the U.S. Department of Justice, Federal Bureau of Investigation, Criminal Justice Information Services (CJIS) Security Policy, Version 6.0, 12/27/2024.
